AFB Recognition Course and Test Registration / Entry Criteria

Legislation:

Biosecurity Act 1993

Biosecurity (National American Foulbrood Pest Management Plan) Order 1998 in

particular Section 31 (aaa)

Scope:

The making available of AFB Recognition Course training and taking the test is a key

objective of the AFB PMP.

Purpose:

To establish a eligibility criteria.

Background:

There is some misunderstanding amongst the beekeeping community where it is

considered the AFB Recognition Course and holding a DECA are one in the same

thing.

Section 31 (aaa) of the Order states that to have a DECA the person/s concerned

must have passed the Management Agencies or other approved course.

In determining this policy the Board of Management contends there is nothing in the Order that prevents a person/s from taking the course and sitting the test at any time. Taken further the person/s do not even have to be interested in bees to sit the

test.

Policy Statement:

Anyone, irrespective of being a registered beekeeper can attend an AFB Recognition

Course and take the test if it is their wish.
