Highlights Report

1. National Bee Health System Project

The Management Agency has successfully migrated all AFB PMP data from ApiWeb to HiveHub. Over 7,600 (73.9%) beekeepers have logged into HiveHub since it went live on Thursday 11 March 2021. The Management Agency also launched the HiveHub landing page on the afb.org.nz website. The landing page provides beekeepers with access to user guides and demonstration videos

Beekeeper feedback demonstrates that most beekeepers have appreciated the superior functionality that HiveHub provides. The Apiary Coordinators have been busy providing beekeepers with support to login for the first time, and assisting beekeepers whose devices are not using the latest operating systems.

Levy invoices were loaded onto the HiveHub on 1 April 2020 and beekeepers where also provided with the ability to submit their Colony Returns and Annual Disease Returns from this date. The Management Agency delayed publishing the availability of levy invoices and Colony/ADR Return functionality until 6 April to avoid generating demand for support over the Easter weekend.

Over 1,100 beekeepers have paid their levy invoices, and the number of beekeepers that have submitted Colony Returns and Annual Disease Returns exceeds 1,600 and 1,400 beekeepers respectively.

The Management Agency will print and post levy invoices and Colony/ADR Return forms to all beekeepers that have not logged into HiveHub by Monday 19 April 2021.

The release of the phone app for Android and iOS has been delayed. The principle causes of the delay was additional work to ensure that beekeepers could use the app when working in locations without cellular coverage – particularly the ability to provide satellite imagery, and the additional requirements to register apps with the Google Play and Apple App Stores.

A small amount of development work has yet to be completed. This includes additional Certificate of Inspection functionality, additional maps for the Operations Managers, and developing reports and dashboards.

2. Certificates of Inspection

722 beekeepers (owning 1,073 apiaries and 7,295 beehives) who have defaulted on both their 2020 Annual Disease Return and Certificate of Inspection were issued with Default Notices.

Default inspections are currently underway. A common reason for a beekeeper to default on their COI (and ADR) is that they have given up beekeeping but have not deregistered. The Management Agency is now encouraging beekeepers that do not meet the legal requirements to be a registered beekeeper (i.e. they don't have at least one beehive on one apiary site) to deregister as most of these beekeepers do not realise that by staying registered they are obligated to comply with plan rules irrespective of whether they have bees or not.

Annual Disease Returns (ADR's)

1,411 (13.7%) Beekeepers have submitted their ADR by 15 April 2021.

Certificates of Inspection

4,616 beekeepers were required to complete a Certificates of Inspection. As of 27 October 2020, 3,568 beekeepers had yet to submit a Certificate of Inspection. These beekeepers were sent an email reminder on 27 October. A further SMS reminder was sent on 9 November 2020, and email reminder was sent on 19 November.

2,984 (64%) Certificate of Inspections were received by 15 December. This is down on Certificate of Inspection compliance in 2019, when 70% of beekeepers submitted their Certificate of Inspection on time. Part of the reason for the difference is that the Management Agency returned incomplete Certificates of Inspection back to the beekeeper for completion this year.

Currently 1,175 beekeepers (owning 2,044 apiaries and 17,417 beehives) have defaulted on their Certificate of Inspection, and 722 beekeepers (owning 1,073 apiaries and 7,295 beehives) have defaulted on both their 2020 Annual Disease Return and Certificate of Inspection.

Beekeepers that defaulted on both their 2020 Annual Disease Return and Certificate of Inspection will be issued with default notices. The Management Agency will inspect their apiaries on default over the autumn and early winter period.

AFB Recognition Course Training

Attendance at training courses has been impacted as a consequence of the COVID-19 lock downs and reduced demand for courses during alert level 1.
