



National American Foulbrood Pest Management Plan AFB Recognitions Course Trainer Application Instructions

Thank-you for your interest in becoming an AFB Recognition Course Trainer. To assist the Management Agency's assessment of your application could you please follow the instructions below:

1. Applicants should submit a covering letter and resume that lists three referees.
2. Applicants should also submit brief answers to the following five questions:
 - a. What is the objective of the National American Foulbrood Pest Management Plan?
 - b. Please describe the key beekeeper obligations under the National American Foulbrood Pest Management Plan.
 - c. Please describe your experience recognising AFB in the field. You should include the details of AFB cases notified to the Management Agency that you had an association with.
 - d. Please describe the major factors associated with the spread of AFB from one hive to another.
 - e. Please describe the key principles and practices associated with eliminating AFB from a commercial beekeeping operation that has experienced an outbreak of AFB.

AND

- f. Please describe your experience either:
 - Delivering training to groups or people, and/or
 - Presenting to groups of people

The information provided in steps 1 and 2 above will be used to shortlist candidates.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend a 'Teams' interview. The interview will be a mix of behavioural competency and AFB inspection and elimination questions.

Reference checks will be completed prior to offering contracts to successful applicants.
